Please be advised, weather permitting, Kantrax Contractors Ltd. will begin culvert/drainage work and roadway repairs. Please remove your vehicles/RV's prior to 7am, for each stage of construction that affects your area. Road Closure Barricades and No Parking Signs will be placed in restricted areas the night before. Temporary road closures will be required so please be aware.

All dates are approximate and weather dependant. We thank you for your patience during construction and renewal of your roadway. We at Kantrax regard safety as a priority and would appreciate your assistance in informing your customers that this construction site will have many dangers and remind them to stay clear from the construction area and use the open sidewalks only.

Kantrax Contractors Ltd. employees and subcontractors are all required to abide by Company Safety Policies and Occupational Health and Safety Regulations to ensure safety to the public and themselves, however, children as well can be attracted to construction sites and equipment. We request your assistance in informing them of the dangers and reminding them to stay away from construction zones. Thank you for your assistance in maintaining safety on our work sites.

During construction, if you require access for any deliveries or drop offs, please contact Mark Trenchard and we will be happy to arrange something that works.

Covid-19 Mitigation

Kantrax Contractors Ltd. is following current public health orders from Alberta Health Services in regards to additional requirements to mitigate the spread of Covid-19. Signage will be onsite at all entrances to the walkways of our site indicating the current requirements in effect for the worksite. We ask that all businesses and their staff stay updated with public health orders as available from Alberta Health Services.

Currently, we require physical distancing of 2.0 meters or 6 feet between all personnel when personal protective equipment is not worn. Please provide this safe working distance from our staff and inform your customers to do the same.

Expect the Following Construction Stages:

1. **Culvert and Drainage Repairs** – Please note that your driveway access will be closed in certain areas only until this repair is completed.

Please see below for a tentative schedule or driveway closures.

Culvert between house # 367 and #363 – **Shutdown August 23-24**

Culvert at house #416 – **Shutdown August 25-26**

Culvert at house #428 – **Shutdown August 30-31**

Culvert at house #432 – **Shutdown September 2-3**

Culvert at house #436 – **Shutdown September 7-8**

Culvert at house #460 – **Shutdown September 10-11**

Culvert at Poplar Close Entrance – **Shutdown Sept 13-14**

2. **Asphalt Pulverization and Overlay** – In preparation for this stage, the road will remain open, however, reduced to one lane traffic during the daytime. We will be using large equipment including road pulverizers/pavers and compactors to mix cement and tack the asphalt. Please note that the cement and tack can be messy. Please keep off with vehicles and foot traffic until it has time to cure.
