2022 Budget Notes:

The overall property assessment in Poplar Bay increase by 11.1% in 2022 compared to 2021.

The 2022 Municipal Property Taxes increased by 1% (\$2,870) to \$295,506 compared to \$292,636 in 2021.

The 2022 Provincial Requisitions increased by 1.0% (\$1,126) to \$232,928 compared to \$231,801 in 2021.

The Municipal minimum Property Tax remained at \$600 for 2022.

The Annual Wastewater Utility fee for 2022 remained at \$240 for all properties.

The Annual Wastewater fees are used to fund the regional wastewater expenses, local wastewater expense and build reserves used to help fund future Capital Project.
